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Safety climate

- Safety climate is defined as workgroup members' shared perceptions of management and workgroup safety related policies, procedures and practices
- It reflects workers' perception of the true value of safety in the organisation

Safety climate dimensions - 50 items

- 1. Management safety priority, commitment, and competence (9 items)
- 2. Management safety empowerment (7 items)
- 3. Management safety justice (6 items)
- 4. Workers' safety commitment (6 items)
- 5. Workers' safety priority and risk nonacceptance (7 items)
- Safety communication, learning, and trust in co-workers safety competence (8 items)
- 7. Trust in the efficacy of safety systems (7 items)


Purpose of NOSACQ-50

- A diagnostic and intervention tool to evaluate the status and progress of safety climate in an organisation
- A benchmarking tool at the group, company, sector, national and international level, generating possibilities for cross-level knowledge sharing

Examples of items

- Management encourages employees here to work in accordance with safety rules - even when the work schedule is tight
- We who work here break safety rules in order to complete work on time

- Freely available in 45+ language versions
- International benchmarks, 750+ studies, 100,000+ respondents, all sectors
