We invite all researchers to submit their abstract within studies on stress in its broadest sense for presentation at the 20th Stress Research Conference.

Deadline: September 11th, 2024. Approved abstracts will be selected for either oral presentation or poster presentation. Feedback will be given by email in late September 2024.

The abstracts, posters, and oral presentations will be in English. The abstract must not exceed 300 words and should be structured: Background, Methods, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion. Please state the primary affiliation of each co-author and note the presenting speaker with *.
