Abstract requirements

Word count max. 300 words. Abstracts should be sent as a Word document to winc2025@nfa.dk.

The following headlines should be included:

- Title
- Author(s) and affiliation(s), <u>underscore name of presenting author</u>
- Introduction
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion

The symposium will feature oral and poster presentations based on the submitted abstracts. Authors are encouraged to indicate their preference for an oral or poster presentation in the accompanying email when submitting their abstract. Additionally, it should be confirmed that the presenting author will be physically present at the symposium.

All submitted abstracts undergo peer-review, and the reviewing committee will notify the authors whether the abstract is accepted as an oral or as a poster presentation. Authors will be notified about this decision March 31, 2025.

Early career researcher workshop

A pre-conference workshop for early career researchers will be held on the May 12, 2025 from 9.00 to 11.30. Early career researchers are students, research assistants, Ph.D. candidates, and postdocs and participants with a similar academic or professional level.
